SOG 102 Line of Succession

- 1 102. Wisconsin ARES/RACES serves a vital role in an emergency by providing critical
2 communications capabilities. The Section Emergency Coordinator function is critical
3 for the efficient operation of Wisconsin ARES/RACES.
- 4 102.1. In the event the Section Emergency Coordinator is unavailable, or for any
5 reason unable, to fulfill his/her responsibilities, he/she shall be succeeded in the
6 following order:
- 7 102.1.1. Assistant Section Emergency Coordinator, Training
- 8 102.1.2. Assistant Section Emergency Coordinator, WEM
- 9 102.1.3. District Emergency Coordinator, Southwest Wisconsin
- 10 102.1.4. Assistant Section Emergency Coordinator, National Weather Service
- 11 102.2. Whenever a subordinate assumes the duties of acting SEC, he/she shall notify
12 the Section Manager, DECs, and ECs by radio, radiogram, email, telephone, or other
13 means.
- 14 102.3. Any person serving as an acting SEC under this SOG shall continue in that
15 capacity until such time as:
- 16 102.3.1. The duty appointed SEC is able to resume his/her duties.
- 17 102.3.2. Relieved by the Section Manager.
